Intred to use Open Fiber network to expand Lombardy FTTH service

Italian fixed-network operator Intred has announced an agreement to use Open Fiber's wholesale FTTH network to expand its service in the Lombardy region. The operator said it intends to invest around EUR 3 million over the next 5 years to bring FTTH to more of the region's main cities, starting with up to 70,000 premises in Brescia from next month.

The deal follows a similar [agreement](#) reached with TIM at the end of last year to use 500 km of dark fibre over 15 years. The EUR 2 million deal will allow Intred to expand its network in 90 localities throughout Lombardy and improve fibre-optic sales in the provinces of Milan, Monza, Lecco and Bergamo.

The transactions are part of the Intred's growth strategy following an IPO that saw the company's shares debut on the Aim Italia market in July.
