Italy's Intred acquires 100% of regional fibre provider Qcom

Intred, an Italian fixed-network operator based in the Eastern Lombardy region, has announced the acquisition of the remaining 25 percent stake in regional fibre provider Qcom it hadn't already agreed to buy. At the start of January, Intred [announced](#) a deal to acquire 75 percent of Qcom for around EUR 8.2 million. It will now pay EUR 10.2 million for 100 percent of Qcom's 1.32 million shares.

Treviglio-based Qcom is active in the Bergamo, Milan, Brescia, Monza and Brianza, Cremona and Varese provinces of Lombardy and specialises in the delivery of broadband and ultra-broadband connectivity, fixed telephony, data centre and IT security services to over 4,000 business customers.
